POLICY STATEMENT

Dayton High School offers an online learning program that allows students to recover credits to get back on track, to earn credits in classes we do not offer or to resolved scheduling conflicts. The online learning program is an internet based program (PLATO) that allows students to earn or recover credits. The following are stipulations regarding the credit recovery program:

- A student needing to recover 2 or more credits will have a credit recovery class scheduled.
- A student in credit recovery for one class period must recover 1/2 credit per semester. Students with an IEP may have additional time to complete a credit.
- The DHS administration must approve all classes before a student is enrolled in a credit recovery class. Failure to do this may result in the loss of the credit for the student.

Below are the stipulations students must abide by to be enrolled in the credit recovery program and while they are enrolled in the credit recovery program:

- A student must pay \$5 to be enrolled in an online learning class.
- A student must earn at least a 60% on all online course assessments assigned after the course pre-test. Failure to a 60% will result in paper/pencil tutoring sessions until the acceptable score is earned.

The following stipulations will apply for the online learning program in summer school:

- A student must pay \$60 to be enrolled in a summer school course. A student will not begin summer school
 until the money is paid.
- A student must earn at least a 60% on all online course assessments assigned after the course pre-test. Failure to a 60% will result in paper/pencil tutoring sessions until the acceptable score is earned.

**The DHS administration makes the final decision on all issues regarding the credit recovery program.
