- Mr. Workman: 5<sup>th</sup> year here- 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade rotation have been tried different years One day a week didn't work out well Trimesters were tried but and proved challenging for grading purposes this year we are seeing the same group of the 8<sup>th</sup> graders we can allow students earn a half credit of PE 43% of the students are obsessed Keeping the 8<sup>th</sup> grade class as a yearlong class then we should allow them to get a high school credit as an 8<sup>th</sup> grader. This will allow students to take advance PE this could help with athletic competitive with other schools and reduce the number of injuries. Would like to see the 8<sup>th</sup> grade go back to a four-quarter rotation.

#### **Committee Reports:**

Special Education – Information presented by Angela Buschle, and other Special Ed teachers added input when needed. It doesn't fit the model to allow to use the percentage of failing – The failing percentage doesn't mean the same as for a regular education class. Students that are failing have mandatory homework help, calls home, modified tests and quizzes, small group instructions, extended time, reader/scribe when allowed, collaboration with regular education teachers and weekly grade monitoring, they may also receive academic detention and counseling students.

Library – No students are currently failing in STLP, Intro to STLP, and Career and College exploration – Ms. Boyers went over the library report

# Student Achievement Report/Data and School Improvement Planning

- o Case Testing presented by Mrs. Goetz and Mr. Kellinghaus
  - 8<sup>th</sup> grade reading: 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 55% to 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter 32% needing intervention
  - 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Math: 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 41% to 33% in 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter needing intervention
  - 7<sup>th</sup> grade reading: 66% students needed intervention during 1<sup>st</sup> quarter to 46% needing intervention in 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter
  - o 7<sup>th</sup> grade math: 57% student needed intervention in first quarter to 48% of the students needing intervention in 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter
  - We need to utilize the Case results better to better serve the students teachers have already started using the data and adjusting student assignments based on the data and involving the students.
